- **Applications for the funds will need to be assessed in the period from the end of August 2021 – 31st May 2022.** Applications received will be evaluated via Zoom meetings once every two or three months, depending on the number of applications received (planned Zoom meetings: **end of August 2021, end of January 2022, end of March 2022 and end of May 2022**), respectively.
- In addition, **the assessment period for all funds related to the International MWIA congress will be from 1st October-15th November 2021.** Assessment will be done using a standardized grading template for each fund and this needs to be submitted 2 weeks prior to the Zoom meetings. Eligible candidates for membership in this committee should have the time capacities to be available during the pilot phase -**1st July 2021- 31th May 2022-** for grading of applications.
